**Policy 7312
Student Dress Code**

The following dress code will be enforced by any Franklin Central School employee.

A student's dress and appearance, including hair, jewelry, make-up and nails, shall:

- a) Be safe, appropriate and not disrupt or interfere with the educational process.
- b) Recognize that extremely brief garments such as tube tops, net tops, halter tops, spaghetti straps, plunging necklines (front and/or back), garments which expose midriff, extremely short skirts or shorts and see-through garments are not appropriate
- c) Ensure that underwear is completely covered with outer clothing.
- d) Not include the wearing of bulky or long outdoor coats or apparel in the classroom.
- e) Include footwear at all times.
- f) Not include the wearing of head coverings in the classroom except for medical or religious purposes.
- g) Not include items that are vulgar, obscene, libelous or denigrate others.
- h) Not promote and/or endorse the use of alcohol, tobacco or illegal drugs and/or encourage other illegal or violent activities.

Student dress and appearance must be in accordance with the District Code of Conduct. The administration is authorized to take action in instances where individual dress does not meet these stated requirements.
