Mrs. Johnson reported the following to the board:

- Mr. Coyle provided a Principal's Report:
 - Shanna Sheldon-Boning was invited up to present the Franklin
 Community Education Foundation scholarship to Sydney Elmendorf.
 - 3-8 testing has been completed. Thank you to the teachers for their work with this.
 - Thank you to Miss Fowler and Mr. Hammond for handling the 4 & 8 science testing.
 - The Exhibition Night was a huge success. It was great to showcase student's work and have parents back in the building the enjoy it.
 - O It's a busy end of year with field trips to the Train Museum, Fenimore Glass Museum, Proctors for a show, Vroman's Nose Trail Hike, Prom and After Prom.
 - Upcoming dates
 - 6/17 Kindergarten Graduation
 - 6/21 Elementary Awards & 6th grade graduation
 - 6/24 Graduation
 - Mr. Lohraseb did a presentation on 6th grade and student will have a simulated HS schedule for one day and meet teachers.
- Mr. Wood gave a Building and Grounds Report:
 - o There was 100ft of asbestos abated
 - New floors installed in parts of the building
 - Home Ec room was converted to a classroom

- Work was done in the cafeteria
- o Old divider was removed in the gym
- New stairs going to the fields
- o Flooring in the elementary hallway and two rooms will be updated
- Mrs. Terry gave a Cafeteria Report:
 - Served 19,853 breakfast meals, 24, 198 lunch meals, for total of 296 meals a day.
 - o Sold more than 2,500 cookies
 - o It was a pleasure having the kids back in the cafeteria, we love the kids and we know what they like and don't like.
 - Mrs. Terry thanked Stanley Swears for his service and dedication to the school and community.
- Mrs. Johnson thanked the management team for all they do behind the scenes, especially during COVID with this changing daily. Mrs. Terry, Mr. Van Kingsley, Mrs. Renwick, Mr. Nolan and Mr. Wood have been the back-line support.
- There is a national struggle to fill positions. There are 340 open positions. SUNY Oneonta saw an 84% drop in graduates in the field of education. There used to be over 600 students and this year there were 95 students graduating. We need to find ways to get students excited to teach.
- We are looking into starting a NYS HS Clay Target League. We hope to have this set up for the fall. Areas school involved in this league include Bainbrige, Laurens, Sidney, Walton, and Worcester.
- An update on the FCS/Unatego Shared Athletics:
 - o Working on deadlines for committee to determine if shared is needed
 - o Provide as many sports to students
 - We play in Section 4 with Unatego in the MAC League and FCS in the Tri-Valley League
 - o Working on a game site schedule
 - Board of Education will make final decision
 - We reached out to FCS students to see who is interested in volleyball and only one student showed interest.
 - Girls modified and varsity soccer is good. Boys soccer will merge with FCS.
 - Modified and varsity football will merge with Unatego.
 - Sport banquets were held and Unatego players came to Franklin and Franklin went to Unatego.
 - o A spring survey will be going out.
- We have two new employees, Teagan Mackey and Paul Lackos. Teagan is covering AIS while Mrs. Huber is on leave and Paul Lackos has returned to FCS as a custodian/bus driver.
- Mrs. Johnson thanked retirees Mary Lou Miller, Jayne Bolton, Cindy Carey and Debra Valentine for their service to FCS.
- Mrs. Johnson noted the retirement of Stanley Swears from the Board of Education and presented him with a plaque. Vice President Patricia Taggart spoke a few words about Stanley.

WHEREAS, at the Annual District Meeting of the qualified voters of Franklin Central School District, Delaware and Otsego Counties, New York (the "School District"), held on May 17, 2022, a proposition was duly adopted authorizing the Board of Education of said School District to undertake the purchase of school buses, including incidental equipment and expenses in connection therewith, at a maximum estimated cost of \$130,000, such proposition providing for the levy of a tax therefor to be collected in installments, with up to \$130,000 obligations of said School District to be issued in anticipation thereof; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to provide for the authorization of such purpose and for the financing thereof; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, by the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the total voting strength of the Board of Education of Franklin Central School District, Delaware and Otsego Counties, New York, as follows:

Section 1. The purchase of school buses, including incidental equipment and expenses in connection therewith, at a maximum estimated cost of \$130,000, in and for the Franklin Central School District, Delaware and Otsego Counties, New York, is hereby authorized.

Section 2. The plan for the financing of the aforesaid maximum estimated cost shall be by the issuance of \$130,000 bonds of said School District hereby authorized to be issued therefor, pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 3. It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid class of objects or purposes is five (5) years, pursuant to subdivision 29 of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law.

Section 4. The faith and credit of said Franklin Central School District, Delaware and Otsego Counties, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds becoming due and payable in such year. There shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property of said School District, a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due and payable.

Section 5. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the President of the Board of Education, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said President of the Board of Education, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 6. All other matters except as provided herein relating to the bonds herein authorized including the date, denominations, maturities and interest payment dates, within the limitations prescribed herein and the manner of execution of the same, including the consolidation with other issues, and also the ability to issue bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, shall be determined by the President of the Board of Education, the chief fiscal officer of such School District. Such bonds shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in Section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law, and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals, in addition to those required by Section 51.00 of the Local Finance Law, as the President of the Board of Education shall determine consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 7. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:

- 1) Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said School District is not authorized to expend money, or
- 2) The provisions of law which should be complied with as of the date of publication of this resolution are not substantially complied with,
- and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or
- 3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution. Section 8. This resolution shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150-2. Other than as specified in this resolution, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein.

Section 9. This resolution, which takes effect immediately, shall be published in summary form in the official newspaper of said School District for such purpose, together with a notice of

the School District Clerk substantially in the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law – Resolution #21-245
