Immunization Requirements for Students in Grades 11 & 12**

Date:

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations. They are listed below.

**Required Immunizations for Students in Grades 11-12**

Immunization	Number of Doses
DTaP/DTP	3 doses
Tdap	1 dose
Polio	3 doses
MMR	2 doses
Hepatitis B	3 doses or 2 doses of adult hepatitis B Vaccine (Recombivax)
Varicella (chickenpox)	1 dose
Meningococcal conjugate (MenACWY)	By Grade 12: 2 doses or 1 dose if the dose was received at age 16 or older

\*Note: MenACWY vaccine is not required per NYSDOH for grade 11.

**Immunization Requirements for Pre-Kindergarten Students**

Date:

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter Pre-kindergarten and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations. They are listed below.

**Required Immunizations for Pre-Kindergarten**

Immunization	Number of Doses
Polio	3
Hepatitis B	3
Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis	4
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	1
Varicella (Chickenpox)	1
Hemophilus Influenzae	1 to 4
Pneumococcal Conjugate	1 to 4

Proof of immunization should be sent to the school nurse.

Proof of immunization must be **any 1 of the 3** items listed below:

- An immunization certificate signed by your health care provider
- Immunization Registry report (NYSIIS or CIR from NYC) from your health care provider or your county health department
- A blood test (titer) lab report that proves your child is immune to the diseases
  - For varicella (chickenpox), a note from your health care provider (MD, NP, PA) which says your child had the disease is also acceptable.

**Immunization Requirements for Students in Kindergarten, Grades 1, 2, 3, & 4**

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter kindergarten and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations. They are listed below.

**Required Immunizations for Kindergarten & Grade 1, 2, 3, & 4**

Immunization	Number of Doses
Polio	4 doses or 3 if the 3rd dose at 4 years of age or older
Hepatitis B	3
Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis	5 doses or 4 doses if the 4th dose given at 4 years of age or older or 3 doses if 7 years or older and was started at 1 year or older
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	2
Varicella (Chickenpox)	2

Please send proof of immunization to the school nurse.

Proof of immunization must be **any 1 of the 3** items listed below:

- An immunization certificate signed by your health care provider
- Immunization Registry report (NYSIIS or CIR from NYC) from your health care provider or your county health department
- A blood test (titer) lab report that proves your child is immune to the diseases
  - For varicella (chickenpox), a note from your health care provider (MD, NP, PA) which says your child had the disease is also acceptable.

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter Grades 5 and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations. They are listed below.

**Required Immunizations for Students in Grades 5**

Immunization	Number of Doses
Polio	3
Hepatitis B	3
Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis	5 doses or 4 doses if the 4th dose given at 4 years of age or older or 3 doses if series stated at age 7 or older
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	2
Varicella (Chickenpox)	1

Proof of immunization must be **any 1 of the 3** items listed below:

- An immunization certificate signed by your health care provider
- Immunization Registry report (NYSIIS or CIR from NYC) from your health care provider or your county health department

New York State Law Section 2164 requires certain immunizations (shots) to enter and attend school. Please check with your health care provider as soon as possible to make sure that your child has all the needed immunizations. They are listed below.

**Required Immunizations for Students in Grades 6, 7, 8, 9, & 10**

Immunization	Number of Doses
<b>DTaP/DTP</b>	<b>3 doses</b>
<b>Tdap</b>	<b>Age 11:</b> Must receive an immunization containing Tetanus Toxoids, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis (Tdap)
<b>Polio</b>	<b>4 doses</b> or <b>3 doses</b> if the 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose was received at age 4 or older
<b>MMR</b>	<b>2 doses</b>
<b>Hepatitis B</b>	<b>3 doses</b> or <b>2 doses</b> of adult hepatitis B Vaccine (Recombivax)
<b>Varicella (chickenpox)</b>	<b>2 doses</b>
<b>Meningococcal conjugate (MenACWY)</b>	<b>1 dose</b> <b>Grade 7 or 8* or 9*</b>
* Most of the students in grade 8 and 9 will have already received the MENACWY vaccine dose in grade 7, unless transferred from out of state or out of country. MenACWY vaccine is not required per NYSDOH for grade 10.
